2 dozen bagels -- plain or assorted (2 rowers)
Assorted tubs of cream cheese/butter/margarine (2 rowers)
24 Hamburgers (5 rowers) 120 total
48 Hamburger buns (3 rowers) 144 total
48 Cheese slices (American) (2 rowers) 96 total
50 Hot dogs (all beef) (3 rowers) 150 total
75 Hot dog buns (2 rowers) 150 total
Assorted side dishes (4 rowers)
Assorted desserts (5 rowers)
1 large jar peanut butter and jelly (1 rower)
2 large loaves of bread (1 rower)
Assorted bags of chips/goldfish/Pringles (3 rowers)
2 Bottles of Ketchup/Mustard/Mayo (1 rower)
Cut up Lettuce, Onion and Tomato (2 rowers)
1 jar each of relish and dill pickles (1 rower)
Plates & Napkins -- enough for 200 (1 rower)
Cups -- enough for 250 (1 rower)
Plastic spoons, forks, knives -- enough for 200 (1 rower)

I need several people to volunteer to bring coolers filled with ice. (Rolling coolers work best as you may have to walk on a path to the site where the team will be set up.

I'll need grill masters ... and apprentices, too!

If there's anything you think I've forgotten, please let me know ... on second thought just bring whatever you think I've forgotten.

We will provide Water Tea, and Lemonade, but feel free to bring your own favorite (non-alcoholic) beverage.
